Several people have already caught the error (see "Letters," *Electronics Now*, January 1999)—cutting the Möbius Strip results in TWO intertwined hoops, not ONE larger hoop as stated. Many thanks to all who responded, renewing my faith in our readers. Now, if you want to see something really strange, try cutting the two intertwined Möbius Strips down *their* centers....
